# SLSSC 2.01: CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 1<sup>ST</sup> STATE LEVEL SCHEME SANCTIONING COMMITTEE MEETING (SLSSC)

The minutes of the 1st SLSSC meeting held on 6 August, 2010 was confirmed.

#### SLSSC 2.02 ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The action taken report of first SLSSC meeting was put up before the committee. Agenda Item wise details are as under:-

## AGENDA NO. 1.1: APPROVAL OF WATER SUPPLY SCHEMES FOR COVERAGE OF UNCOVERED POPULATION:

It was apprised that work is ongoing in 5 dovetailed schemes. Further more; the State Government has sanctioned 12 new water supply schemes. Tenders have been invited for sanctioned schemes. Apart from this the approval of remaining 5 water supply schemes under process at the State Government level.

ACTION TAKEN 1.1- The directions of the committee is being complied. Scheme wise progress is enclosed as Annexure-2.02.1.

#### AGENDA NO. 1.2: ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR F.Y. 2010-11:

#### ACTION TAKEN 1.2-

It was apprised in the meeting that Annual Action Plan of F.Y. 2010-11 of all components under NRDVVP has been entered in the IMIS of Drinking Water Gol website. It was clarified in the meeting that as per directions of the 1st SLSSC only those water supply schemes have been taken up which are likely to be completed within 3 years.

- ❖ The Committee directed that Rain water harvesting structures should be standardized different technological options such as Ferro Cement, RCC and PVC etc. The Committee further directed that by 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2011 Uttarakhand Peyjal Nigam in association with Swajal, Uttarakhand Jai Sansthan and SWSM should complete this job and put up the proposals before the Principal Secretary & Chairman SLSSC at 12.30 PM on 31<sup>th</sup> January, 2011. The discussion note regarding community contribution should also be put up on 31<sup>th</sup> January 2011.
- The Committee expressed its deep concern on the slow rate of expenditure in execution of water supply schemes as well as in operation and maintenance subhead and directed all the implementing agencies to utilize the funds at the earliest so that request for II<sup>nd</sup> installment may be sent to the Gol.

## SLSSC 2.03 APPROVAL OF NEW WATER SUPPLY SCHEMES

The proposal for approval of 36 new water supply schemes costing ₹25820.72 lakh and 2 continuing schemes to be dovtailed costing ₹2045.12 was put up before the Committee. The total estimated cost of 2 continuing schemes is ₹4601.52 Out of which 50% share of work cost amounting to ₹2045.12 lakh will be borne by NRDWP (Central).

The SLSSC approved the above proposal. The detailed list of schemes is annexed as Annexure 2.03.1

# SLSSC 2.04: POLICY FOR EAR MARKING OF FUNDS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES UNDER SUPPORT ACTIVITY FUND

It was apprised that as per present guideline of NRDWP the water supply projects have to be prepared in consultation with the communities. This entails community mobilization, formation of Village Water & Sanitation Committee (VWSC), Base line data collection (PFR), Planning phase activities by hiring the services of Non Governmental Organization (NGOs.), Therefore it is essential to finance the expenditure under this subhead from the Support Activities Funds from NRDWP.

The Committee directed that detailed proposal should be sent to the Gol.

## SLSSC 2.05: ANY OTHER POINT WITH THE PERMISSION OF CHAIR

The following points were taken up with the permission of the chair

SLSSC 2.05.1: The Committee directed that schedule of rates should be updated every year in the month of April. All the estimates should be prepared on current district schedules of rates and the project report of the estimate should specifically mention the details about the applicable schedule of rates.

SLSSC 2.05.2: It was brought to the notice of the Committee that there should be different schedule of rates for execution of work by the communities and by the department. The schedule of rates applicable for communities should not contain contractor's profit. The Committee directed that all estimates to be put up before the SLSSC must confirm to these directions.

SLSSC 2.05.3: The provision for Catchment Area & Conservation Management Programme (CACMP) should not be on lump sum basis but the Detailed Project Report (DPR) should have details of works along with unit cost.

SLSSC 2.05.4: All the schemes to be put up before the SLSSC for approval should necessarily have Bar/Flow Chart specifying the important milestones such as invitation & finalization of tender, award of work, quarterly progress report review etc.

SLSSC 2.05.5: The Committee was of the view that there appears to be skills gap especially in adopting to computerization and community mobilization. It was agreed that the Uttarakhand Peyjal Nigam will assess its training needs and put up the proposal before the next SLSSC meeting.

SLSSC 2.05.6: The Committee directed that all the implementing agencies should invariably include on priority basis work relating to sustainability measures (Rain water harvesting) in those villages where water supply schemes are being implemented by the concerned agencies under the Sustainability Component of NRDWP.
