SLSSC AGENDA 3.01: CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 2ND SLSSC MEETING.

The minutes of the 2nd SLSSC meeting held on 20th January, 2011 was confirmed.

SLSSC AGENDA 3.02 ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The action taken report of 2nd SLSSC meeting was put up before the committee. Agenda item wise action taken report is as under:-

(i) Agenda no. 2.03: Approval of New Water Supply Schemes

It was apprised that work is complete in one dovetailed scheme. DPRs of 15 new water supply schemes have been technically approved by the competent authority. Apart from this, DPR of three new pumping schemes have been prepared and their technical approval is in process. It is expected that DPRs of another 13 schemes will be ready by 30th June, 2011. It was apprised that five proposed schemes under NRDWP have been dropped as they have been financed under other programs of state. It was brought to the notice of the Committee that central share is yet to be decided by State Government in one scheme of Pauri District: Bhairav Garhi Pumping Scheme

Action Taken 2.03: The Committee took note of the action taken. The scheme wise progress is enclosed as Annexure- 3.02.2.

(ii) Agenda no. 2.04 : Policy for Ear Marking Of Funds for Community Development Activities under Support Activity Fund

It was apprised that the financing of Planning Phase activity under NRDWP is not admissible as per present NRDWP Guidelines. The Committee had directed that the matter should be referred to the Government of India.

Action Taken 2.04:

1- The direction of committee has been complied and accordingly the request has been sent to the Joint Secretary, Gol for consideration.

2- It was agreed in the meeting including by the GoI member Mr. D. Rajasekhar that the financing for pre planning (Base line data collection, i.e. Pre- feasibility report), Planning phase activities support (Community mobilization by NGO, formation of User Water and Sanitation Committee) and implementation phase activities support could be admissible under support activity fund of the NRDWP. However, formal approval may be taken from GoI as community mobilization is a part of IEC activities and can be funded from 5% NRDWP-Support funds.

(iii) Agenda no. 2.05: Any Other Point with the permission of chair

Agenda No. 2.05.1: The Committee had directed that schedule of rates should be updated every year in the month of April. All the estimates should be prepared on current district schedules of rates and the project report of the estimate should specifically mention the details about the applicable schedule of rates.

Action Taken 2.05.1: The direction of committee is being complied with. The Committee took note of the action taken.

Agenda No. 2.05.2: The Committee had directed that there should be different schedule of rates for execution of work by the communities and by the department. The schedule of rates applicable for communities should not contain contractor's profit. The Committee directed that all estimates to be put up before the SLSSC must confirm to these directions.

Action Taken 2.05.2: The direction of committee is being complied. The schedule of rate applied for communities is without Contractors Profit. The Committee took note of the action taken.

Agenda No. 2.05.3: The committee had directed that the provision for Catchment Area & Conservation Management Programme (CACMP) should not be on lump sum basis but the Detailed Project Report (DPR) should have details of works along with unit cost. Every effort should be made to dovetail MNREGS funds for undertaking excavation works pertaining to sustainability structures.

Action Taken 2.05.3: The direction of committee is being complied and the estimates for CACMP works is being framed separately under sustainability component. The Committee took note of the action taken.

Agenda No. 2.05.4: All the schemes to be put up before the SLSSC for approval should necessarily have Bar/Flow Chart specifying the important milestones such as invitation & finalization of tender, award of work, quarterly progress report review etc.

Action Taken 2.05.4: The direction of committee is being complied. The Committee took note of the action taken.

SLSSC 3.03: Approval of New Water Supply Schemes under NRDWP:

The proposal for approval of 49 new water supply schemes costing to Rs. 28628.28 lakh was put up before the committee. It was apprised that DPRs of 11 new water supply schemes costing Rs. 5979.40 lakh out of total 49 water supply schemes have been technically approved by the competent authority. The DPRs of remaining 38 new water supply schemes costing Rs. 22648.88 lakh are under preparation and are likely to be ready before 31st December, 2011.

The SLSSC approved the proposal for all new water supply schemes (The list of sanctioned schemes is attached as Annexure - 3.03.1) except two schemes i.e. Chinwari Danda & Dhikwal Gaon Pumping W/s Scheme schemes. The Committee gave following directions: -

To reduce the cost of Chinwari Danda & Dhikwal Gaon Pumping W/s schemes. River bank filtration should be tried in place of proposed Intake well. The trial test for river bank filtration should be completed within 3 months and detailed report should be put up in the next SLSSC meeting. The funds required for trial and testing activities will be made under support fund of NRDWP. It was also agreed in the meeting that in MVS schemes provisions contingencies and work charge establishment should be provided @5% and 3% of work cost respectively as per ARWSP norms.

2-As far as possible gravity fed water supply schemes should be proposed for coverage of habitations. Pumping Schemes should be proposed only when there is no gravity source

available in the area concerned.

Presently, the pumping plants having the capacity of pumping head up to 1500 meters are 3available in the market, so in case of multi stage pumping schemes effort should be done to reduce number of pumping stations to make it cost effective and economical. The Committee further directed that energy efficient pumping plants should be used in new water supply schemes.

It was agreed in the meeting that a combined team of Assistant Engineer to Superintending Engineer level officers (Civil & E&M branch) of Uttarakhand Peyjal Nigam, Uttarakhand Jal Sansthan, Swajal & SWSM should visit Himanchal Pradesh for study of

high head pumping schemes.

5-It was agreed in the meeting that state should identify a reputed technical institution as state technical agency (STA) which will assist the state department to plan and design sound and cost effective rural water supply schemes and to provide feedback to the SWSM/SLSSC/PHED on various aspect of programme. Also, no project should be put up for approval to SLSSC without approval of STA. Experienced faculty from NIH and IIT Roorkee may be included in the STA with MD, UJN and CGM, UJS as members. 6-

For installation of 576 new hand pumps costing Rs. 478.57 lakh, in minority domainated villages of Haridwar district. Requirement of funds may be sent to Ministry of Minority Affairs, Gol through the respective DC/DM. If this fund is not available, NRDWP-coverage

funds could be utilized.

SLSSC-3.04: Approval of proposal for immediate repair/restoration of water supply schemes damaged due to natural calamity:

It was apprised that about 5955 rural water supply schemes out of a total 11338 in Uttarakhand State were damaged in the month of August & September, 2010 due to heavy rains, floods and landslide. The proposal for immediate repair/restoration of damaged works of 1380 water supply schemes, costing Rs 7019.00 lakh was put up before the Committee for approval under NRDWP calamities fund. The agency wise detail is as under:-

It was clarified that the each scheme taken up under NRDWP Natural Calamity Fund will adhere to NRDWP guidelines i.e. (i) escalation in cost of NRDWP schemes due to time and cost overrun will not be met out of NRDWP funds (ii) the funds provided under NRDWP will be used to meet the expenditure on approved schemes and (iii) centage charges will not be met out of NRDWP funds.

The SLSSC approved the above proposal & directed that the restoration of damage works should be completed within 3 months period. The Committee also directed that out of 133 damaged schemes proposed by Uttarakhand Peyjal Nigam only those schemes should be taken by the Uttarakhand Peyjal Nigam which have not been taken over so far by Uttarakhand Jal Sansthan.

The List of approved rural water supply schemes is attached as Annexure 3.4.01

SLSSC 3.05: Approval of establishment of Water Quality Analysis laboratories at district and sub divisional level:

It was apprised that the water quality surveillance and monitoring programme on a regular and continuous basis has remained a neglected and low profile area over the years due to paucity of fund, limited infrastructural facilities as compared to demand and shortage of skilled man power. The proposal of Rs 666.33 lakh for establishment of new 10 district level, new 41 sub divisional level water analysis laboratories and up-gradation of 3 district level laboratories under WQM&S of NRDWP was put up before the Committee.

It was brought to the notice of Committee that GoI had already released Rs 126.16 lakh during FY 2010-11 under Support Fund to the SWSM which in turn has been transferred to Uttarakhand Jal Sansthan for establishment of water analysis laboratories. The available amount Rs 126.16 lakh will be spent for establishment of 10 district level new laborites and up gradation of 3 district level laboratories

The SLSSC approved the proposal with following directions:-

1- Establishment of 10 new district level laboratories and up gradation of 3 district level laboratories should be done within the period of 3 months.

 Existing water testing laboratory at Dehradun should be up graded as State Level Referral Laboratory.

SLSSC 3.06: Approval of Annual Action Plan 2011-12:

It was apprised that the final Annual Action Plan 2011-12 after updation has been sent to Department of Drinking Water, Gol. The details of physical and financial component wise action plan of NRDWP are as under:

SLSSC approved the above proposal with following directions:-

1- The Committee expressed its deep concern on the slow rate of expenditure in execution of water supply schemes as well as other sub components of NRDWP and directed that all the implementing agencies should utilize 60% of available funds at the earliest so that the request for 1st installment for FY 2011-2012 may be sent to the Gol.

2- Target should be given to all implementing agencies for roof top harvesting schemes under

sustainability sub head.

3- The schools which cannot be covered by pipe water supply schemes should be covered by

roof top rain water harvesting.

4- One hydro geologist under support fund should be appointed in each district through SWSM who will be attached with Uttarakhand Jal Sansthan and will assist all implementing agencies.

SLSSC 3.07: Any other point with the permission of the chair.

The following points were taken up with the permission of the chair.

SLSSC 3.07.1: Approval of project for study on GIS, Mapping of water sources in Uttarakhand using Global Positioning System.

Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Project (Swajal Project) was directed by the Chief Secretary to conduct a study on GIS, Mapping of water sources in Uttarakhand using Global Positioning System vide GO No. 338 dated 5th March, 2009. Accordingly the Terms of Reference (ToR) was prepared and got approved by the World Bank. The procurement process was started by the PMU in November, 2009. However due to many hurdles the study could not start. Currently it was found feasible get the study done through Survey of India. The detailed estimate of the work is Rs 227.60 lakh as per annexure 3.07.1 prepared by PMU. The PMU has apprised that Rs 80.00 lakh is available under World Bank project. The balance amount Rs 147.60 lakh should be made available under the Support Activity fund of NRDWP. The matter was put up before the SLSSC for approval of the above project. The representative of Uttarakhand Jal Sansthan apprised that Uttarakhand Jal Sansthan is also collecting the data of about 1000 habitations by engaging Sri Ram institute, New Delhi.

The Committee approved the proposal and directed that the work should be done by only one agency so that chance of duplicity could be avoided. It was also directed by the Committee that Uttarakhand jai Sansthan should transfer the all available data of 1000 habitations to the PMU.

SLSSC 3.07.2: Delegation of power to sanction new water supply schemes projects in anticipation of SLSSC meeting

It was apprised that "One of the policy issues mentioned in the National Rural Drinking Water Programme guideline is about delegation of power for giving technical and administrative approval to the State Government in order to avoid administrative bottlenecks in the execution of the rural water supply schemes and related Support activities viz., CCDU, WQM&S, MIS, R&D, M&E, STA etc. The delegation of powers is subject to the condition that the State Governments have to ensure that proper system of close monitoring and evaluation is in place. The State Governments should furnish complete and timely information to enable the Government of India to release funds regularly"

NRDWP guidelines also provide that meetings of the Committee should be held at least twice in a year, wherein apart from sapctioning new schemes, progress, completion and commissioning of the schemes approved earlier by the Committee should be reviewed. Some time there might be some exigencies where in the regular SLSSC meeting may not be possible to be called. The matter was put up before the SLSSC that the Principal Secretary, Drinking Water/Chair person SLSSC should be authorized to sanction new proposal in case of urgency subject to approval of the project in the next SLSSC meeting.

The Committee approved the above proposal and directed that the approved proposal by the chairman should be put up in the next SLSSC meeting for ratification.
